Josie Couch (Ensemble) This is Josie's first production with Lionheart. She was previously on stage in The Hunchback of Notre Dame in summer youth theatre.

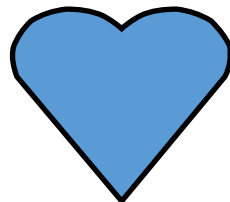
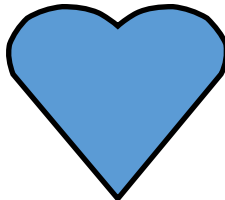
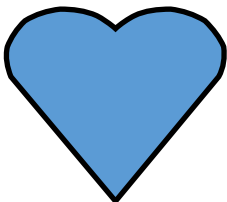
CAST BIOS
